RULES

- NJ State Fishing Regulations apply.
 - A valid New Jersey fishing license is required for residents at least 16 years and less than 70 years of age (plus all non-residents 16 years and older) to fish the fresh waters of New Jersey, including privately owned waters. Resident anglers age 70 and over do not require a fishing license or Trout Stamp.
- Lake Vreeland is a catch and release waterway. All fish taken must be returned to the water as quickly as possible alive and unharmed.
- Barbless hooks and Lead-free sinkers only are to be used. They will be available for sale at the trading post for your convenience.
- One Fisherman – One Line – One Hook. Spin or Fly Rod.
- Live Bait may not be used - it increases gut hooking
- NO FISHING FROM THE DAM. Please fish in our designated areas.
- Please dispose of monofilament in designated receptacles and dispose of all trash properly.
- Check in begins at 8AM - the fishing competition will begin at 10AM and continue until 2PM. After that point the results to be tallied.
- Results must be individual (no teams).
- Unsportsmanlike behavior may be cause for disqualification.

CAMP GLEN GRAY INFO -

- Glen Gray is designated for overnight, wilderness camping – entrance is by permit only. Check in and check out at the headquarters building.
- Staff is in residence 24 hours at the headquarters building to assist you when camp is open.
- Latrine facilities are located throughout the camp. Please dispose of all litter properly, a bear proof dumpster is located in the parking lot.
- Day activities such as Hiking and Fishing are not allowed with the exception of scheduled special events.
- Numerous trails exist for the enjoyment of our guests, please stay on the trails while hiking and respect our flora and fauna.
- This is a wilderness area inhabited by wildlife – take all necessary precautions.
- Well water is available year round in two locations and plumbed throughout the camp seasonally. Check with the camp office. Make certain that all faucets are closed tight after use.
- No alcohol or other intoxicating substances allowed.
- No smoking beyond the parking lot.
- No Hunting, Firearms or Archery is permitted.
- Open fires are by permit only when conditions allow.
- No motor vehicles or bicycles beyond the parking lot.
- Lake Vreeland is a catch and release waterway. All fish taken must be returned to the water as quickly as possible alive and unharmed.
- NO FISHING FROM THE DAM. Please fish in our designated areas.
- Camp Glen Gray is a Bergen County Park and all county regulations to be observed.

Take Route 202 South past the Ramapo Reservation

Just before the Oakland border, turn Right onto Glen Gray Road

Cross the bridge, turn Right and follow the road up the hill to camp

From Route 287 and south

Take Route 202 North just past the Mahwah border

Turn Left onto Glen Gray Road

Cross the bridge, turn Right and follow the road up the hill to camp
